



PEAK OPERATIONS: MID MARCH THRU EARLY MAY

- Mid March 2020: Census count starts in Remote Alaska
- Materials mailed to most homes in 3 waves over ~7 days
- People can self-respond through July



20% of homes also get paper form in 1st mailing.



Telephone response option also available to all




80% of homes get letter inviting Internet response.

Note: Residents will receive a paper form eventually if they don't respond on-line or by phone.


Digital Census Score Card Local Focus - New Orleans, La (Census Data, 2018)






Households with Computers: 79.1% (-8.1%) Households with Broadband: 66.1% (-12%)
