Redistricting Criteria

All plans are subject to the Voting Rights Act and must comply with the following criteria:

- (a) **The districts must honor Equal** population standards (ie Ideal Deviation, etc).
- (b) District boundaries must coincide with the boundaries of political subdivisions.
- (c) **The district must be contiguous** in one piece, sharing a common border;
- (d) **The districts must be compact**, Compact districts tend to resemble geometric shapes (not animals)
- (e) A district may NOT be drawn for the purposes of favoring a political party or an incumbent legislator or member of congress.
