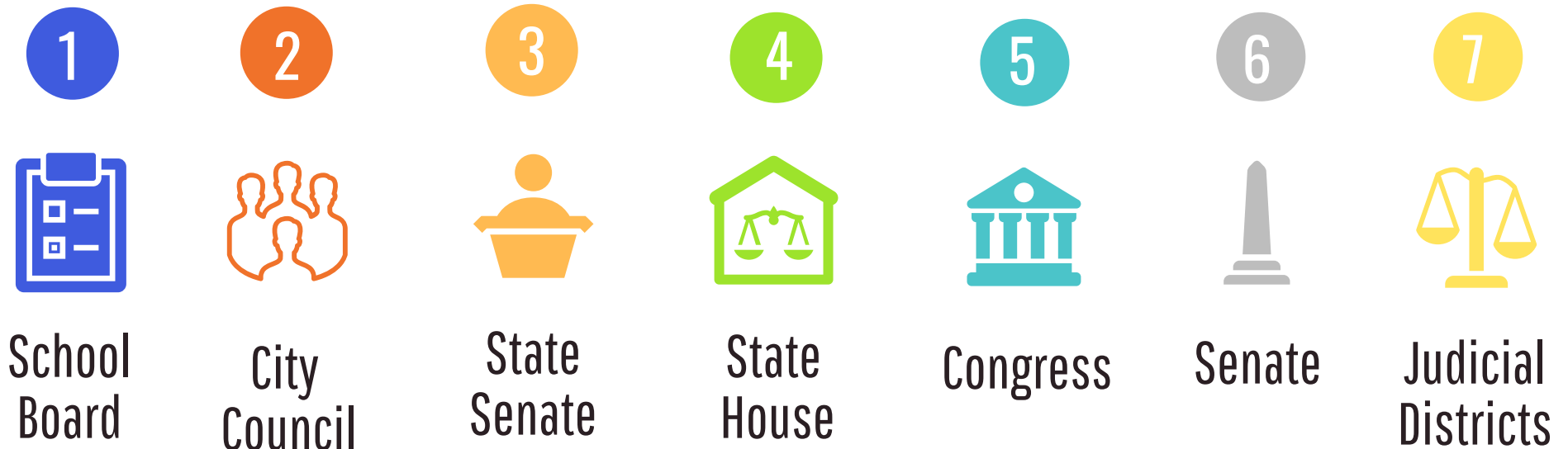

Redistricting

Redistricting is the process by which political boundaries are redrawn. Occurs every ten years post Census and Reapportionment

Principals

- Compactness
- Contiguity
- Prohibition on favoring or disfavoring incumbent, candidate or party
- Prohibition on using partisan data
- More...

Annexation Trend

- Annexation is a legal process by which some property located in an unincorporated area of a township may become part of a neighboring city.
- Annexation as a part of redistricting plans or strategies can increase or decrease a city or districts population
